

Ellora from 8,000 miles:

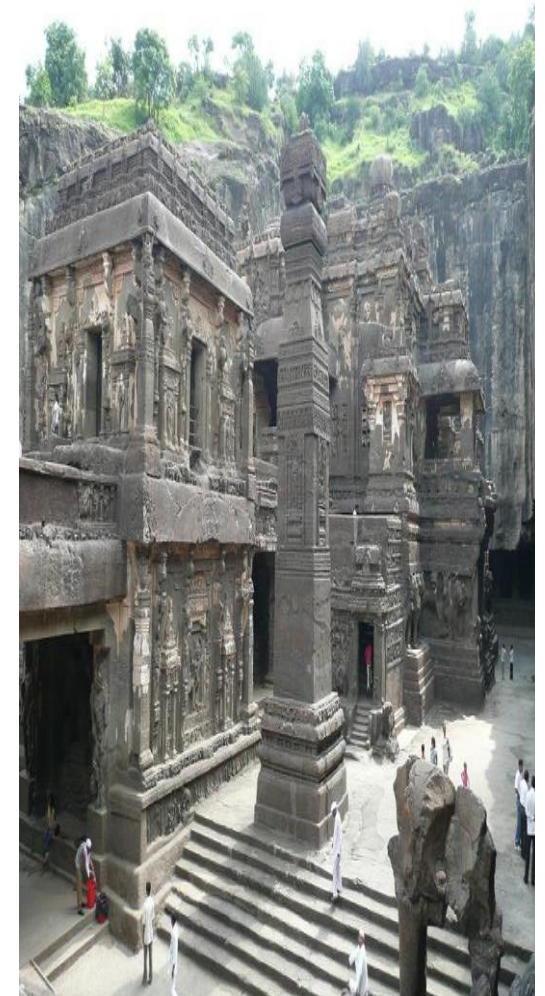
