The Results are In...

Last years' research showed Salisbury University Students were at risk for Acetaminophen (Tylenol) poisoning. Did you know?

- Tylenol can kill taking > 4 extra strength pills in one day is an overdose!
- Tylenol OD's can have the same symptoms as a HANGOVER!
- Mixing Tylenol with Alcohol increases liver damage more than alcohol alone & can be fatal!

"The Tylenol (Acetaminophen) Rules" for College Students:

- 1. Never take Tylenol 6 hours before or up to 24 hours after alcohol, or to 'treat' a hangover.
- 2. ALWAYS eat something prior to alcohol use or when taking acetaminophen.
- 3. Look on labels of ANY medicine you are about to take to see if it has acetaminophen in it. (OVER 200 over-the-counter drugs contain acetaminophen!)
- 4. Ask your doctor if acetaminophen is in any prescribed medicine OR interacts with your prescribed medicine.
