

The ratio of boys to girls in a class is 5 to 4. If there are 27 students in the class, how many are girls?


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- 3. Place each of the following numbers in scientific notation.

7. Classify each curve as simple, simple closed, closed, or none of these.










- 8. If r and s are parallel lines and the measure of $\angle a$ is 35°, find the measures of each of the following angles.
