Todd:

10 minutes \rightarrow 3 newspapers
 20 minutes \rightarrow 6 newspapers
 30 minutes \rightarrow 9 newspapers

Total for Todd:

9 newspapers

Shauna:

12 minutes \rightarrow 4 newspapers
 24 minutes \rightarrow 8 newspapers
 30 minutes \rightarrow 10 newspapers

Total for Shauna:

10 newspapers

$4/12 = 1/3$ So Shauna sells 1 news paper every 3 minutes. Therefore, from 24 minutes to 30 minutes (a difference of 6 minutes, or 2 sets of 3) is equal to 2 newspapers.

The combined sales for Todd and Shauna in 30 minutes is 19 newspapers
