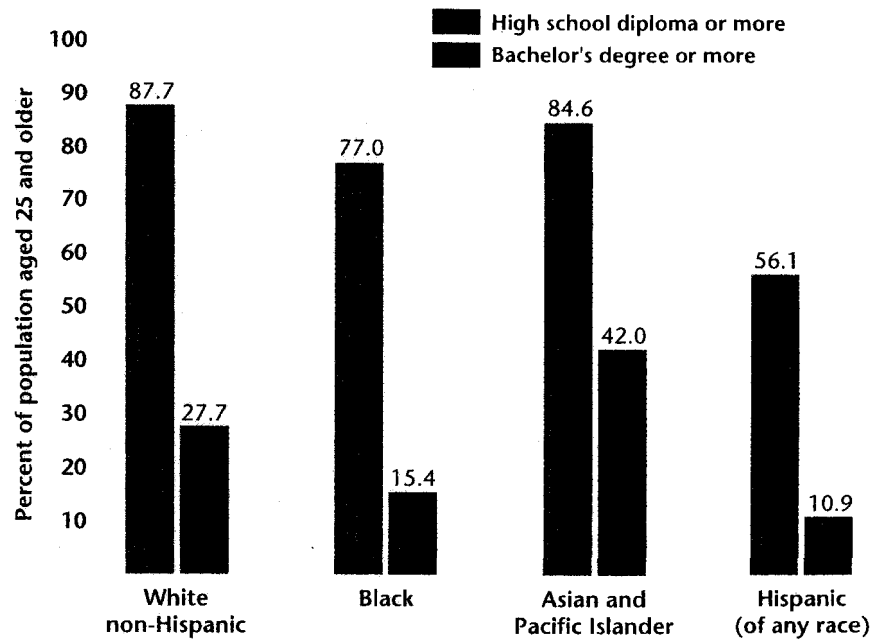


**FIGURE 8.3**

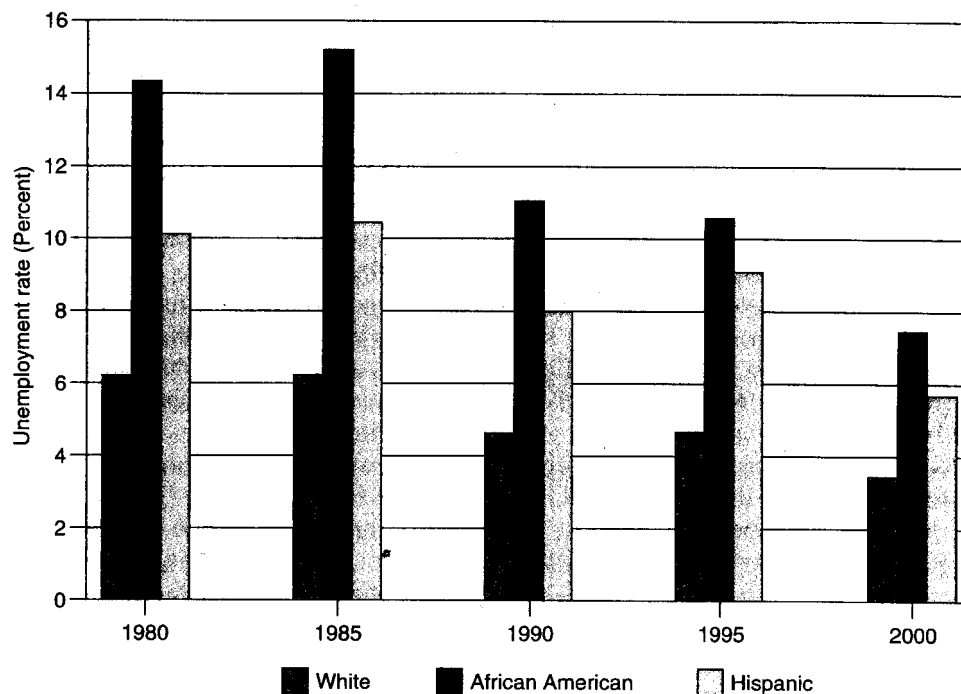

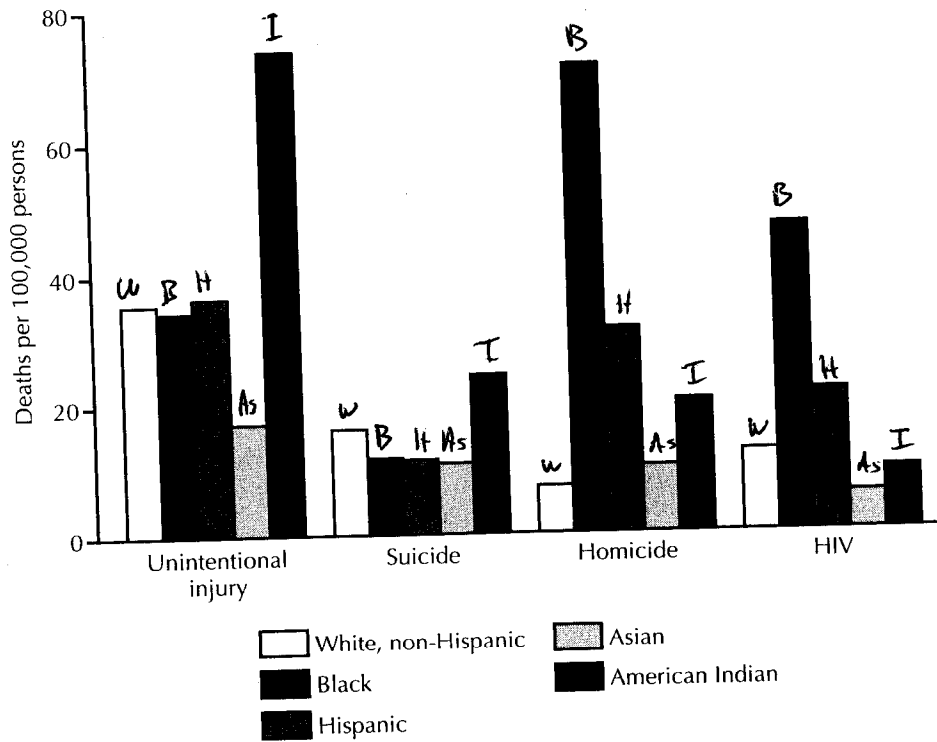

**1980-2000.**

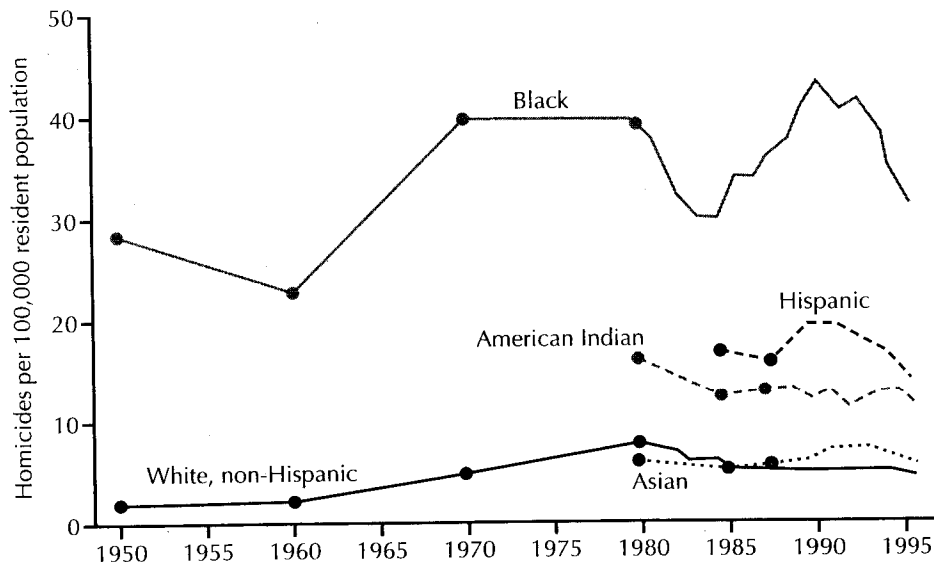

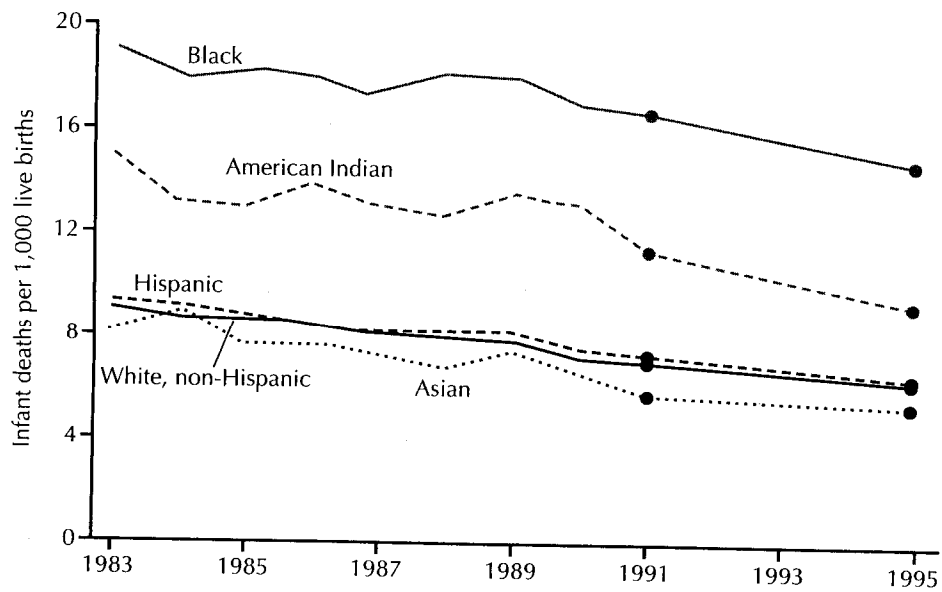




**FIGURE 8** Death Rates by Cause, for Persons Aged 15 to 34, 1996 to 1995. Data for 1994 and 1995 are averaged to provide more reliable estimates. HIV data for American Indians are for 1993–1995. *Source:* Council of Economic Advisers (1998).
